Graduation Requirements

To receive a Bishop Moore Catholic H. S. diploma, students must:

- Achieve a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.
- Earn 28 credits.
- Complete 25 hours of community service per year of attendance at BMC.

Senior Year Expectations


It is each student's responsibility to:

Recommendations and Essay Writing

For Recommendations, Students Should :

*Add College Counselor

*Ask for recommendations from junior or senior year CORE teachers who can speak to the

student's strengths, values, and interests

*Give teachers at least two weeks notice

*Ask in person and follow up with an email

*Complete the FERPA section of Common App with accuracy

The Main Personal Statement should:

*Be written in a student's voice and involve limited editors

*Provide additional information not elsewhere listed in the application

*Answer "So What?"

*Avoid commonly used subjects and "hot topics"

*Use tactics to create "Storytelling Gold" (Active verbs, sensory details, numbers and statistics, dialogue, figurative language, proper nouns, etc-)

*Essay presentation & brainstorming exercises were saved to Naviance under "Documents"

The Common Application

- Common App vs. Institutional Applications
- Update all required areas accurately and completely
 - For any questions, please see C&C Counselor directly

• My Colleges Tab

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- Various needs/expectations for the different schools
- MUST submit (and pay) for each individual application
 - You cannot assume completing the Common App means you are done

• After applications are submitted...

- Check your email regularly
- Submit SSAR/SPARK/etc
- Submit Test Scores
- Complete any other institutional requests ASAP

Transcripts and SSAR/SRAR

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Types of transcripts: Unofficial, Official, SSAR/SRAR, SPARK

Official- Ordered through Parchment, contact Michelle Vazquez-Langan

- Required by some schools as part of application
- Will have to request official transcript at the end of the year

SSAR/SRAR (Self-Reported Student Academic Record)

- MUST complete with unofficial transcript (will be checked against official at end of year)
- 9 major FL Universities accept SSAR (including UF, FSU, USF, UNF)
- Each school has different requirements to link to application/deadlines

- App Checklist, College Comparison / Fin. Aid Comparison Wkshts

FAFSA and Bright Futures

- FSA ID now (parents + students)
- Bright Futures (November/December)

Remember:
